CALLED TO SERVE cut the corner into the first turn while close up, settled back a bit further past the three quarter pole, rated back and shifted out with five furlongs remaining, was soundly bumped when moving between runners nearing the far turn, leveled off into a nice stride soon after and took aim on the leader past the three eighths pole, forged clear when put to strong hand urging in mid stretch, eagerly widened and cruised home through the final seventy yards. **EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH** cleared early, set the pace two to three wide, was collared past the three sixteenths marker, drifted in, continued willingly and was clearly best of the rest. **HUGHES NEXT**, in close soon after the break, saved ground off the pace, finished with interest and earned the show in the final jumps. **THUNDER LORD**, brushed soon after the break, was taken five wide for the backstretch run, bumped with **TONTO FONTENOT** when gaining some ground approaching the far turn, circled into the lane, lugged in and was outfinished for the show. **PRETENSION** stalked the pace three wide, bumped with the winner nearing the far turn and tired. **TONTO FONTENOT** moved up four wide leaving the five eighths pole, bobbled when exchanging bumped between runners nearing the far turn, retreated soon after then fell galloping out. **AVENIDA PASEO**, between rivals early, chased the pace for a half mile then faltered.
