Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2001-2002 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. LIGHTS ON BROADWAY stalked the pace in hand, drew even with the leaders near the half-mile pole, took command leaving the second turn, and held well under strong handling. CAPTAIN COUNTDOWN was well placed while saving ground, angled out near the three-sixteenth pole, gained gradually through the stretch, but couldn't get by the winner. WON C C raced three wide entering the first turn, set the joint pace down the backstretch, battled willingly through the lane, and just held the show. DESERT DEMON was bumped at the start, settled near the back of the field, and finished willingly to just miss the show. SMILING PRINCE was hustled along to set the joint pace, vied through the final turn, and faded. D C STORM was always outrun.
