Footnotes

PERCY HOPE vied for the early advantage from the start, forwardly placed throughout, dueling with TAKE A GAMBLE, drove clear down the stretch and won driving. FIFTY STARS unhurried in the early going, racing in the back of the pack, moved up on the outside around the second turn, made a late rally, but couldn't catch the leader. GIFT OF THE EAGLE raced within contention early, evenly behind the leaders, made a bid after turning for home, but proved 3rd best. ME AND THEE lacked early speed racing off the rail down the backside, made a mild bid, but was no factor. TAKE A GAMBLE vied for the early lead, saved ground throughout and faded after turning for home. SOLINGEN pressed the pace, racing outside around the first turn, faded entering the final stretch. HOOVERGETTHEKEYS was unruly in the gate, then raced in the middle of the field, moved up on the outside around the final turn, then retreated. HALO'S SHADOW bobbled at the break, racing inside near the rear, lost contact with the field.
