**Footnotes**

GOLDEN EURO tracked the pace, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, drew clear leaving the far turn, drifted out in mid-stretch and held under strong urging. RAMESES THE GREAT settled off the pace, moved out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well but was too late. NUGGETS PLEASE settled in the middle of the field, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while just up for the show. FIRST ACT raced three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was roused on the far turn and improved position. TOTAL POWER raced up close to the pace, chased on the far turn and came up empty. BRADY THOMAS settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, steadied briefly at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPIDERMAN RIDGE settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in mid-stretch and failed to rally. RUSH FOR GOLD lagged well back in the field, came out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. DUBLIN ROAD set the pace, lost the lead midway through the far turn and gave way. VALUED ASSETS raced towards the front of the field, saved ground on the turns and had nothing left. GO FOR DOUGH lingered towards the rear, raced three to four wide on the far turn and was no factor. KING KAISER raced three to four wide on the first turn and was outrun. (Rail at 0 Feet)
