**Footnotes**

BIG JOHN was ridden along while off the pace, advanced four wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch and drew away under steady urging. CHANDAS was void of speed, split rivals midway through the turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and reached his best stride too late while up for the place. ODDS ON PETE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, was fanned six wide near the three-sixteenths pole and got up for the show. CAMP VENTURA showed good speed then chased the pace, dueled on the turn and tired. MY DESTROYER threw his head after the start, raced well back in the field, went four to five wide on the turn, was fanned seven wide near the three-sixteenths pole and improved position. BANGO sped clear early and set the pace, dueled inside on the turn and weakened. MOONCOIN CAT broke outward and hit the gate, was hard ridden on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SOUTHPOINTSSKIBO raced well back in the field, steadied near the quarter-pole and failed to menace. RAILHEAD was off slow then forced in, rushed up on the inside, saved ground on the turn and was used up. DOT'S TWO SOCKS was ridden along towards the rear, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. SPRING MISSION hesitated at the start then was taken up, rushed up through the field, chased three wide on the turn and capitulated. POWER TRAIN broke inward at the start, was ridden along near the inside and retreated.
