PALACE RUMOR was allowed to settle into stride, raced four wide on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. D FINE OKIE raced three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was roused on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and closed well but failed to overtake the winner. JUBILEE set the clear pace through quick fractions, was collared near the sixteenth-pole and tired. DURRYMANE raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was roused while three wide on the far turn, shifted in inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. COMALAGOLD bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased the leader into the final furlong and gave way. BEAU HAPPY settled well off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out a bit at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. PEPPERMINT PENNY jostled with a rival after the start then was taken back, lagged at the rear of the field and failed to threaten. TAWNKA bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and came up empty. TOUCH OF CREME jostled with a rival after the start, lingered towards the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns and was no factor. PERFECT RUBY broke a bit slow, was caught four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while three to four wide on the far turn and dropped out. OSWEGO settled in fourth, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and stopped. (Rail at 0 Feet)
