PLEASE US vied for the lead between rivals, came around the turn on the outside, drove clear late under steady urging. FAITH HOPE LOVE pressed the pace from the start, forwardly placed throughout, but couldn't match strides down the home stretch. PROPER PRECISION within contention outside, came around the turn on the outside and finished willingly. DON'T PANIC void of early speed, came around the turn six wide and gained ground down the home stretch. GENIUS BABY forwardly placed on the rail, raced close throughout, finished evenly. MISS RUBY ANNA broke near the front, eased near the back and finished in an even effort. DANCE TIME N TEXAS got off to a slow start, racing near the back of the pack, came down the final stretch racing wide and proved no threat. KYA got in tight quarters at the start and never was in contention. SLEW CITY LADY raced near the back and never showed any run. TWICE A NATIVE pressed the pace inside, dropped back. LITTLE MISS CHIEF vied for the early advantage, raced on the rail around the turn, then stopped.
