NOTHINBETTERTODO was hustled to the lead, set the pace under pressure, kicked clear at the top of the stretch and drew off under strong urging. PEPPERMINT BLING settled while under some urging, raced off the rail on the turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. BIDDY LULU was last away, raced off the pace while urged along, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. MIRACLE ON HIGH was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. DISCUSS THIS was ridden along at the rear of the field, raced a bit off the rail on the turn and was no factor. IDE BET DIXIE was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. AT THE NET pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and tired.
