COL. WRIGHT quickly sped clear, controlled the action through the turn, responded well in the stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. ACES N KINGS was urged along in third position, raced three then two wide on the turn and secured the place while no threat to the winner. HER MAN was ridden along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn and earned the show. PERFECT PARKER reared at the start, broke about five lengths behind the field, raced at the back, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. EL CHELERO chased the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn and tired. MALABAR SLEW dropped back just after the start, was urged along towards the rear and never reached contention. BENESTAR was urged along on the inside, took an awkward stride leaving the backstretch, dropped back and came up empty. Following a stewards' inquiry into the start, there was no change made. (Rail at 0 Feet)
