Footnotes

PRIMAL JONES bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, rallied on the inside of THAT'S OUR ROMEO, battled with that rival in the final sixteenth and narrowly prevailed. THAT'S OUR ROMEO was ridden along on the outside, advanced five then four wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, drifted out shortly thereafter, held a clear lead into the final furlong, battled with the winner in the final sixteenth and just missed. BIG BAD BABE bumped with a rival at the start then was slow into stride, dropped to the inside while at the rear, saved ground on the turn and finished willingly for the show. ABBY BOY bumped twice with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field, went two then three wide on the turn, moved to five wide inside the quarter-pole and just missed the show. SLEWSH BOX bumped twice with a rival at the start, chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and tired. OUR DIVA FACTOR chased the early pace then dropped back, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. MUSICAL MAGNACAT was sent hard from the start, contested the pace on the inside, chased late on the turn and gave way. APPARENT WIND raced well back in the field, went three to four wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole and was no factor. TURN TO TEXAS raced towards the rear of the field, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. MERCY CITY was hustled from the outside, contested the pace, vied three then two wide on the turn and capitulated. ITRON'S JERSEY was sent hard from the start, pressed the pace between rivals, chased two then three wide on the turn and stopped.
