COWGIRL N UP showed good speed, set the pace, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, quickly extended the advantage at the three-sixteenths pole and drew off under strong urging. SID'S KID settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and secured the place. ROCK STEADY BABY chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired while able to get the show. IM A BEAR was ridden along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn, came between rivals in upper stretch and failed to rally. STORMY DONNA GAIL chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and weakened. QUEST FOR CANDY broke a bit slow, rushed up on the inside, made a mild bid near the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back while inside on the turn and capitulated. WHY'S THAT settled on the outside, went four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. BRIDAL TRAIN broke a bit slow then dropped back, fell well behind and trailed. (Rail at 0 Feet)
