AMAZING SAINT showed good speed, set the pace under moderate pressure, controlled the action while three to four wide on the turn, accelerated away when asked in upper stretch, raced under a drive into the final sixteenth then was flagged with the whip while much the best. DO YOU LIKE ME NOW tracked the pace on the outside, chased four to five wide on the turn, pursued the winner in upper stretch and was second best. WAMPAS KITTY settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the turn and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. PHILOGYNY settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went two then three wide on the turn and failed to respond. LOOSE PLAY pressed the pace on the outside, chased while off the rail on the turn and tired. THE GARDENER settled off the pace, moved closer near the half-mile pole, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. REBECCA'S BAY broke in and was slow into stride, dropped well behind, raced inside on the turn and trailed.
