OMNITAP went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, was asked approaching the three-sixteenths pole, quickly took the lead, accelerated clear in upper stretch and drew away under steady urging. DREAM SEQUENCE settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn and safely secured the place. DULCE DE BATATA went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while five wide on the far turn, moved closer into the stretch but came up empty while best of the rest. COOKIN GONE BAD went four then five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, made a strong middle move, vied three wide on the far turn and tired. B'S BABY GIRL went five then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. MISS MULLIGAN went five wide early on the first turn then dropped to the three path, lingered well back in the field, raced off the rail on the far turn and was no factor. NO SHRINKINGVIOLET was hustled from the start, went three to four wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn and faded. GLORIOUS DEVON set the pace on the inside, vied into the stretch and stopped. LITTLE MISS TISSY lagged towards the rear, saved ground on the turns and was outrun. WHAT'SYOURTROUBLE broke two lengths slow, went six then five wide on the first turn, raced well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn and showed little.
