**Footnotes**

FLIGHTY FRIEND was bumped between rivals after the start, raced off the pace while ridden along, went five wide on the turn, rallied six wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead passing the furlong marker and prevailed under good handling. SWEET WILL was urged along while just behind the wall of leaders, steadied while blocked from the three-sixteenths pole to the eighth-pole, found room shortly thereafter and finished willingly while unable to match the winner. CHICKASAW NATION bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along near the inside, raced off the rail on the turn, was blocked entering the stretch, moved out outside the furlong marker and also finished willingly. GLASS MACHINE dueled between rivals, vied into the final furlong and tired. JOESFULLOFIT dueled on the outside of several rivals, vied four wide while between horses on the turn, battled into the final furlong then weakened. SHAKE A LAKE broke outward and bumped with a rival, was well placed just behind the leaders, saved ground while urged along on the turn and came up empty. CAPTAIN LISTO was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, lacked room entering the stretch and failed to rally. GOLDEN GOLDEN chased the pace on the outside, vied five wide on the turn and gave way. RARE TRAVELER was hustled from the start, dueled between rivals, vied three wide while still between rivals on the turn and also gave way. NO SMALL STAR broke outward then bumped with a rival after the start, raced near the back of the field and was no factor. KARAMA DIF bumped with a rival after the start, lacked early speed, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. WILD TALK dueled on the inside, dropped out while in a bit tight at the top of the stretch and stopped.
