KELLVILLE contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, inched clear coming to the quarter-pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch and drew off under steady urging. THUNDER AND BELLE chased the trio of leaders while on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, pursued the winner into the final furlong, drifted in late and earned the place. MINOR ISSUES steadied near the five-eighths pole, was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and narrowly earned the show. LOVE CHAMONIX settled off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and just missed the show. SOPHISTICATED GAL was ridden along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn and failed to rally. SWEET MARGI disputed the pace while between rivals, vied into the stretch and gave way. SHE IS A OLMOS stumbled badly at the start, moved up on the inside to contest the lead, vied inside on the turn and tired. ROYAL TIKA reared badly at the start, spotted the field around five lengths, was urged along on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten.
