MR. WHY WHY tracked the pace, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, inched clear into the final sixteenth and prevailed under strong urging. PATCHWORK settled off the pace, moved up some while off the rail on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. DADDY BEN raced just off the pace, was asked to move up nearing the half-mile pole, took the lead shortly thereafter, inched clear near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out in upper stretch, had the rider lose his whip inside the furlong marker and weakened while clear for the show. IHEARUCALLINGME brushed with a rival at the start, raced towards the rear, went four then five wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. J W FLYER was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and tired. TAHOKA was hustled from the start, raced just off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn and came up empty. F P REIGN'S LAD was taken in hand leaving the chute, settled off the pace, raced inside on the turn, checked sharply near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. TIME FOR TROUBLE was hustled to the lead, set the pace, lost the advantage outside the seven-sixteenths pole, vied two then three wide on the turn and stopped. ORIENT DANCER lunged at the start then brushed with a rival, dropped back while racing erratically, went four to six wide on the turn and was outrun.
