DANCIT dueled on the inside of BEGG'S while well off the rail, vied three wide on the turn, drew clear in upper stretch and proved much the best under enthusiastic hand urging. KING GULCH was away awkwardly, raced well back in the field, went three wide on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. TRACK RECORD was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. SHOE SHOE SHOE was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. BEGG'S dueled on the outside, vied four wide on the turn and tired. I'M THE CAT was bumped in the hindquarters after the start, chased the early pace then dropped back, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. MR. CHIPS bumped with I'M THE CAT after the start, raced well back in the field and was no factor. WEST COAST OFFENSE was very reluctant to load, chased the early pace then dropped back, raced inside on the turn and stopped.
