HIGH ONA DREAM saved ground racing in the middle of the field, started her bid at the half mile pole and won driving. MAGIC MOOD unhurried early, made her move turning for home and made a late gain. DON'T PANIC outside speed down the backside, opened up around the turn, tired late. DARE BUNNY raced in the middle of the field, made a mild bid. KAISERINCHEN broke slow, came around the turn wide and gained ground. INCIDENTAL FINDING outrun early, improved position. BELLE OF THE BALL inside speed, faded. I'M BLUE TOO void of speed, no factor. NICE TRICK never close. MME. SOLEIL pressed the pace between rivals, dropped back. SWEET BERNADEAN within striking distance, retreated while racing wide in the turn. MINING NORTH showed little.
