Footnotes

DONERAILE'S PEAK was well placed on the inside, moved between rivals near the three-eighths pole, waited patiently leaving the far turn, rallied inside nearing the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong handling. LAYO raced three wide on the first turn, lagged well behind the field, rallied on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong and finished willingly but was second best. GABRIEL'S MISSION raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, bobbed multiple times leaving the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and gave way grudgingly. CATAPULT SHOT brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along at the back of the leading group, moved out on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. WACO WOLF raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and came up empty. SUDDENLY KOOL brushed with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside of GABRIEL'S MISSION and faded.
