Footnotes

MILLIGRAM broke outward and brushed with a rival, was allowed to settle towards the middle of the field, advanced while four wide leaving the backstretch, gained the lead passing the quarter pole, was set down in upper stretch, and drew clear while drifting out. TIVA'S LITTLE SIS broke outward and hit the gate, angled to the rail leaving the chute, settled at the back into the backstretch, advanced on the outside with a half mile to run, was in perfect striking range leaving the final turn, roused in upper stretch, but was only second best. PETIONVILLE INDEED raced four wide entering the first turn, prompted the pace from the outside, vied for the lead into the stretch, but was no match for the top two. WEE OKIE stalked the pace through the final turn, went four wide into the stretch, and weakened. LE BEAU LEI was well placed early, raced in mid pack down the backstretch, and failed to rally. MEXICAN MOONLIGHT was brushed at the start, set the pace under a hold, lost the lead on the final turn, dropped out near the quarter pole, and faded. MARLEY'S DANCER raced well back in the field, and failed to threaten. BANKRUPE settled while saving ground, continued to save ground through the final turn, moved to four wide entering the stretch, and was no factor. CONDESCENDING was always outrun. OUI OUI CHEROKEE was an inside pace factor, dropped out with three furlongs to run, and was eased in the stretch then walked off.
