Footnotes

ATREVIDO BANDITO lugged out on the first turn, set the clear pace, lugged out on the second turn, came in passing the furlong marker then drew clear under strong urging. IDA BET YUKON TOO was carried three to four wide on the first turn, tracked the solo leader, chased that rival while three to four wide on the far turn, moved in at the top of the stretch, steadied near the furlong marker then proved no match for the winner. TWO JAYS SECRET was a bit rank early then settled off the pace, came under a ride on the far turn and failed to rally while best of the rest. FLY SO OPEN brushed with a rival after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, lagged at the back, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. WACO HUG broke outward and bobbed a bit then brushed with a rival, lingered towards the rear, came three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. TACO TODDY was fractious in the gate, settled in the middle of the field, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. Following a stewards' inquiry, ATREVIDO BANDITO was disqualified from first and placed second for interference near the furlong marker
