Footnotes

HY ROZ went three then two wide on the first turn, moved to a clear lead, controlled the action through the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, was challenged by MZ ATTICA near the sixteenth-pole, battled with that rival while rubbing saddles late and just held. MZ ATTICA raced seven wide into the first turn then angled in towards the back, settled off the pace, advanced while ridden along towards the inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, loomed alongside the winner at the sixteenth-pole, battled with that rival while brushing saddles late and just missed. MYSTIQUE NIGHT went two to three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide coming to the top of the stretch, pursued the top two under a drive and finished willingly for the show. ABBIES KRISTEN dropped well behind while three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along on the far turn, remained well back into the stretch and finished with belated interest. PARQUETERIE was last away, dropped to the inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. APRIL MAY FLY was rated while four wide early on the first turn, dropped in late on that bend, raced under tight restraint on the backstretch, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. E CLASSIC went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and tired. DO'S DEVIL CAT broke a bit awkwardly then brushed with a rival, settled just off the pace while off the inside, came up empty on the far turn and faded. HELLO HELLO HALO was returned to the paddock for a new rider then a bit reluctant to load, went six then five wide on the first turn, raced off the pace, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and faltered. BANT AMMI tracked the pace, was through after a half-mile and stopped.
