RITZ MASTER broke near the back of the field, chased early then moved up between rivals to dispute the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and held under strong urging. ROYAL MOCHA was away very alertly, contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, chased the winner in upper stretch, inched closer in the final furlong and just missed in a good effort. DOUBLE OURS broke a bit slow then was taken up, was urged early then settled on the outside, circled five wide on the turn, dropped to four wide entering the stretch, chased into the final furlong and flattened out while clear for the show. BRONCE BELLATOR bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn and failed to rally. COUNTRY SAINT was urged along while off the pace, raced inside early on the turn then moved off the rail and failed to threaten. NEW HIRE was reluctant to load, raced off the pace while urged along, went four wide on the turn and failed to respond. RIGHT CHARLIE settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. ONE MORE FLIGHT contested the pace, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, chased inside on the turn and tired. CHANGING KARMA broke in and bumped with BRONCE BELLATOR, was urged along while off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn and faltered.
