Footnotes

IS IT GOLD was allowed to settle into stride, rallied four wide leaving the turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch, and drew clear under strong urging. LUCKY LI'L IMP was well placed from the start, made a bid on the final turn, battled past the furlong marker, and was second best. KEY ACCOUNT raced four wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, roused midway through the final turn, and was best of the rest. MOTHER MOLLY BOO raced five wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed down the backstretch, gained the lead near the three-eighths pole, was headed passing the quarter pole, and weakened. SUNNY DIVINE raced near the middle of the field, and failed to rally. HAY SHEA had the rider lose his left iron entering the first turn, raced 4wide on that turn, regained the iron near the five furlong marker, went four wide on the final turn, entered the stretch five wide, and failed to threaten. WISHING TO WIN bobbled at the start and bumped with PLACABLE, raced off the pace, made a bid along the rail with three furlongs to run, but faltered and retreated. MISS PROPER TOO was always outrun. PLACABLE was bumped at the start, set the clear pace, was headed passing the three-eighths pole, vied into the stretch, and stopped.
