Footnotes

UNCLE ROSE raced three wide on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear of the field, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed fast to get the lead entering the final furlong then drew clear under strong urging. ROY JONES broke outward at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, raced off the rail on the far turn, dropped in near the furlong marker and got up for the place. CAPITAN JESS raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired while able to save the show. LADITUDE jostled with a rival after the start, lugged out on the first turn, set the clear pace while off the rail, was collared near the furlong marker and weakened. OH OLEG settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. LAST CONQUISTADOR lagged near the back of the field, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. DUSTY TUNNEL was rated in the second flight, raced four wide while urged along on the far turn and came up empty. VIC'S THE MAN jostled with a rival after the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight and faded.
