DRUNK DIAL tracked the leader on the outside, engaged that rival early on the turn, inched clear into the final furlong and was fully extended to last under strong urging. WILBY'S RAY chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, gained gradually in the final furlong and just missed. HARD CASE was hustled to the lead, set the pace, vied inside on the turn and tired. HALIFAX FLYER was ridden along on the outside, went three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. THE DIVINE TUNNEL was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and was no factor. SPARK PLUG lost his footing at the start, broke about two lengths behind the field, raced at the rear and trailed.
