Footnotes

KID KIOWA settled in fourth position, was roused on the far turn, rallied to the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. SUMKINDOFNOTHIN settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, slipped through along the rail in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well for the place. TITO settled on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, moved off the rail at the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the show. HOLLYCAL settled in the middle of the field, went three wide on the far turn and finished willingly to just miss the show. BAG GATE went two to three wide on the first turn, followed the leader from second, moved up with a half-mile to run, vied outside on the far turn, edged clear inside the quarter-pole, remained clear into the final furlong, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and weakened. MIDTOWN GROOM broke a bit slow, lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the turns and improved position. RED HOT QUEST brushed with a rival at the start, settled towards the back, went two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. IRISH QUICKSILVER settled towards the front of the field, chased on the far turn and came up empty. LANG HEART raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. RIVER DANCE went three wide on the first turn, raced near the back of the field, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and was no factor. GULUK BOY brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, went four wide on the far turn and also failed to threaten. ABBIE'S ON FIRE set

the pace, raced inside on the turns and gave way. (Rail at 10 Feet)
