START A REVOLUTION bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, moved up midway down the backstretch, vied outside on the far turn, dueled with TIGER LOVE in the stretch and gamely prevailed. TIGER LOVE contested the pace, battled gamely with START A REVOLUTION in the stretch and missed while just able to hold the place. FANFEST (GB) contested the pace on the inside, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, saved ground on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, battled determinedly in the final furlong and just missed the place. LIKE MY DAD raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under a ride on the far turn and failed to respond. GIANT'S FIRESTONE broke a bit slow then was bumped on both sides, raced three then four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. DYNAMIC TEMPER broke outward and bumped with a rival, was caught four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and gave way. EXCESSERIES was unprepared at the start and broke a bit slow, settled on the inside of rivals while off the rail and failed to menace. PATIENCE RIDGE lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground and showed little. (Rail at 10 Feet)
