BONNIE'S PROSPECT was hustled from the start, went three wide on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, came under some urging while three then two wide on the far turn, responded well in the stretch and held gamely under strong urging. DEACON BOB bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, raced just behind the leader, moved closer with a half-mile to run, vied towards the inside on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and just missed. COOL'S PHIRE raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. BURBON ROAD bumped with a rival at the start, raced inside on the first turn, moved up near the half-mile pole, steadied slightly near the three-eighths pole, lacked room behind rivals passing the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly to just miss the show. CAPTAIN DUDE lingered well back in the field, moved closer on the far turn and improved position. HOLLY JET went three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, was urged along while off the rail early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. NORTH GOAL went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. DAUGHTRY was reserved off the pace, came under urging on the far turn, waited briefly inside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. DUSTY TUNNEL went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR went four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced four then five wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
