SEEKING TO RUN lacked early speed, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole, came seven wide into the stretch and closed strongly to get up late. MAGGIES SNOWMAN broke in the air and a bit slow, moved up then was taken in hand while behind rivals, remained in hand to near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, made a bid near the furlong marker, drifted out while inching clear but was caught. ARANUBA contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired while able to get the show. UP FOR A RODEO contested the pace between rivals then inside late on the turn and gave way. AT FULL PELT was urged along while off the pace, went three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and weakened. VISTA RIDGE contested the pace on the inside, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, chased inside into the stretch and tired. NOBEL LEX was urged along while off the pace, went four wide early on the turn, moved to six wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty.
