MR. MIDNIGHT was reluctant to load, bumped with a rival at the start then was forced in sharply, moved up on the inside, shifted three wide inside the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, rallied determinedly into the final furlong and closed well to get up late. MY DEBIT CARD chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. LEE'S SOUTH was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. SUN SHADOW was hustled to the lead, set the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened. POLKA JOKE broke in and bumped with a rival, was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. ODD MAN OUT raced well back in the field, moved out on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. GHOST SKIER showed good speed, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. SIR JAIME was hard ridden on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn and failed to respond.
