

Footnotes

PAD THE WALLET angled in leaving the chute, was reserved on the inside, advanced along the rail near the seven-sixteenths marker, steadied just inside the five-sixteenths marker then again inside the quarter-pole, engaged PROVOBAY near the eighth-pole, dueled with that rival in the final furlong and gamely prevailed. PROVOBAY sprinted clear to set the pace, responded well when challenged at the top of the stretch, dueled with PAD THE WALLET in the final furlong and just missed in a game effort. GOOD HUMOR GAL settled between rivals in the second flight, tracked the leader while outside of PAD THE WALLET on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened then finished on even terms for the show. CITY ZOOM settled between rivals, ranged up while off the rail on the far turn, shifted three wide inside the quarter-pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and flattened out then also finished on even terms for the show. MS. AVIS lagged near the back of the field, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. ILE'D IRISH ROSE was off slow, settled towards the rear of the field, raced four wide on the final turn and showed little. IN THE GRAY was off slow, raced well back in the field, saved ground on both turns and never reached contention. WILLING STAR raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while four wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide entering the stretch and came up empty. RED MOON raced on the inside in the second flight, saved ground on both turns and stopped. SABA raced in the second flight while three wide, came up empty on the far turn and retreated. (Rail at 20 Feet)
