

TAHKODHA HILLS pressed the pace while always close up, angled outside of the pacesetters on the far turn, was under steady urging through the stretch and prevailed. JEBLAR SEZ WHO was caught a bit wide on the first turn, drew on even terms with the leader nearing the half pole, engaged that one and dueled to late stretch but was outfinished. BIG NUMBERS was allowed to settle along the inside early, angled outside of BULLET BUZZ entering the first turn, raced just off the speed, angled four wide approaching the quarter pole, drew on near even terms at the head of the stretch but failed to sustain the effort. NATURE was forced to go four wide on the first turn, fanned six wide leaving the far turn, bumped with BORN WINNER in upper stretch and flattened out. BORN WINNER was a bit rank at the start and steadied slightly, fanned wide leaving the far turn, bumped with NATURE in upper stretch and failed to mount a rally. J W JET was taken clear shortly after the start, set the pace for a half, was engaged by JEBLAR SEZ WHO approaching the far turn, dueled with that one to midstretch and gave way readily. BULLET BUZZ dropped back entering the first turn, raced close up for three-quarters and stopped.
