FLIGHT COURT pressed the pace between rivals, took a short lead in upper stretch, and held gamely under left hand urging. THEATRICAL DANCER was void of speed, raced four wide on the turn, and finished fast. RUHLETTA was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled determinedly into the final sixteenth, and was outfinished. CHECKING IN set the pace under some pressure, lost the lead in upper stretch, and gave way. TALLAHAXIE BLUE broke outward and bumped hard with a rival, settled off the pace, steadied near the three furlong marker, came five wide into the stretch, was within striking range entering the final furlong, but finished evenly. TEQUILACARMENLITA broke outward and bumped hard with rivals on both sides, then was jostled around and shuffled back, raced six wide on the turn, and finished willingly without seriously threatening. MONTREAL PRINCESS broke inward and bumped hard with a rival, raced towards the front of the field, and weakened. IDE BET IT ALL was bumped hard at the start, raced up close while three wide, and faded. I KNOW YOU raced near the back of the field, checked inside the quarter pole, and was no factor. PRECIOUS PRADO raced five wide on the turn, and was always outrun. GLOBAL DANCER was ridden along on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, -dropped back in upper stretch, lacked room late, and failed to menace in a very dull effort.
