Footnotes

AH SEE WAY settled on the outside, bumped with DUSKY BLUE near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced four wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch and closed strongly to get up at the wire. LEZZ dueled on the inside of MISS DEPUTY ITRON, battled gamely in the stretch and was denied at the wire. MISS DEPUTY ITRON dueled on the outside, battled into the final furlong then weakened while able to hold the show. LUCKY LIBBY chased the pace between rivals then on the inside, saved ground on the turn and tired. DUSKY BLUE settled off the pace, bumped with AH SEE WAY near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three wide on the turn and came up empty. LITTLE MISS JAZZ showed good speed between rivals, was taken up near the half-mile pole, chased while off the rail on the turn and gave way. VALID ROCKET was slow into stride, raced well behind the field and never reached contention. TAC STAR was fractious in the gate, came in at the start, raced four to five wide on the turn and was no factor. SISTER REVENGE chased the pace on the inside, steadied near the half-mile pole and retreated.
