STORM TUNER settled off the pace, moved closer while three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, rallied to the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. EURO SILVER JET dropped back on the inside, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well but missed. RICH JEWEL contested the pace, vied near the inside on the turn, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while just able to get the show. WISH YOU GOLD moved up between rivals, raced off the rail on the turn, was blocked from the quarter-pole into upper stretch, moved out for room and finished willingly to just miss the show. KAJIWARA contested the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. HOLLYWOOD ICE lunged at the start but broke with the field, dropped well behind, raced inside on the turn and failed to threaten. EL CHELERO showed early speed then was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and came up empty. (Rail at 10 Feet)
