(PLUS UP TO \$9,000 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2005 allowed 3 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2005, 5 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2004-2005, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, April 13, 2005 with 14 nominations.

TRUE TAILS set the pace under pressure, pulled clear near the half-mile marker, drew off on the turn and proved much the best while drifting out in the stretch. KETCHMEWHEREYOUCAN was bumped after the start, raced on the inside of BAY DANCER while ridden along, raced off the rail on the turn and earned the place. LADY CARMEN was ridden along while lacking speed, raced off the rail on the turn and missed the place. AIRIZON broke outward at the start, settled on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and just missed the minor awards. READY TO LIVE was bumped at the start then pinched back, trailed the field through the turn and failed to threaten. BAY DANCER settled between rivals on the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn and faltered. MS AMERICAN CHAMP broke inward and bumped READY TO LIVE, pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back near the half-mile marker and stopped.
