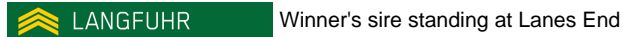

SHOCKTIME was very fast from the gate and quickly sprinted clear, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, responded well in upper stretch and drew off while ridden out. ROSE WITCH chased the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, battled with COUNTING WEST for the place in the stretch and narrowly earned that position. COUNTING WEST chased the winner on the outside then three wide on the turn and proved no match then was caught for the place. GREAT EYES brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, angled in leaving the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. AVEC GLASS was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. J GRAY was reluctant to load, broke in and brushed the gate at the start, raced off the pace while ridden along, dropped back while four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. NASTYLEGS RIDGE was very reluctant to load, raced on the outside while ridden along, went three to four wide on the turn and was no factor. CEA PHER bumped with a rival at the start, dropped back abruptly near the inside, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention. FANNY FLYER was reluctant to load, broke in and bumped with a rival, was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. LITTLE EX brushed with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field, went five wide on the turn and was outrun.
