HALIFAX FLYER moved in while ridden along off the pace, came off the inside on the turn, altered course over heels passing the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker and closed well to get up late. EL OSO chased the early pace, drew even near the half-mile pole, dueled through the turn, battled gamely in the stretch, inched clear into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the place. HARD CASE chased the early pace on the outside then dueled for the lead, bumped three times with WILD SERVE leaving the backstretch, vied four wide on the turn, battled gamely with EL OSO in the stretch and weakened late while able to get the show. SIR JAIME was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, drifted in near the furlong marker, altered course to the outside late and lacked the needed response. MONEY SEEKER showed good speed, dueled on the inside, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased inside on the turn and weakened. WILD SERVE pressed between rivals then dueled for the lead, bumped three times with HARD CASE leaving the backstretch, went three wide on the turn, dropped out near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. MISS ME YET showed no speed and was always outrun. MILES ABLAZE acted-up just as the gate opened, reared and put his head in the stall to the inside then left the rider in the gate. Following a stewards' inquiry into the start, no change was made.
