Footnotes

JAKEONTHERUN raced five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, rallied four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, floated five wide into the stretch, battled with SKIPPY WAS A HIPPIY into the final sixteenth and prevailed while drifting out late. COOKIE RULES raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail into the stretch, shifted out near the furlong marker and closed well to get the place. SEE THE STREAK was caught six wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, settled well off the pace, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to get the show. SKIPPY WAS A HIPPIY raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, vied three wide on the far turn, battled with the winner in the stretch and was outfinished late. B G GIFT EXCHANGE contested the pace on the inside of SKIPPY WAS A HIPPIY while off the rail, battled into the stretch and tired. STRIKE FORCE lagged well back in the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP moved to the inside on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, lacked room behind a stopping rival midway through the far turn, moved around that rival then dropped back to the inside and also failed to threaten. WINNER'S STORY raced four wide on both turns and failed to respond. MALABAR SLEW raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went four then three wide on the far turn and faltered. HOLD'EM PAT raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed in third, came up empty on the far turn and faltered then was pulled up in upper stretch but walked off.
