Footnotes

LUNARPEAL broke outward at the start, settled off the pace, rallied inside on the turn, moved off the rail near the quarter-pole, made a bid between rivals entering the stretch, battled with those rivals into the final furlong then edged clear under strong urging. LA BALA bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, chased four then three wide on the turn, made a bid entering the stretch, drifted out significantly near the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to get the place. MANDATE MAKER bobbled slightly at the start, moved up to contest the pace on the inside, inched clear midway through the turn, was collared at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and weakened while well clear for the show. ROYAL DESTINY broke outward at the start, settled near the back of the field, raced three then four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. OLYMPIC FLYER broke a bit awkwardly, showed early speed then was well placed behind the leaders, dropped back while three wide on the turn and faded. KINETIC SPIRIT broke outward and bumped with a rival, contested the pace on the outside and stopped. OPEN SAM FORUM was off slow, dropped well behind the field and trailed.
