ISNT IT RICH contested the pace on the outside, battled gamely with AFTERNOON CHARLIE in the stretch and prevailed under left hand urging. JOE HENRY moved up on the inside to contest the pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and finished willingly while unable to overtake the winner. AFTERNOON CHARLIE contested the pace between rivals, vied inside on the turn, battled gamely in the stretch but was outfinished. MINSTREL RUNNER bobbled at the start, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the turn and came up empty. FAST FASHION steadied while in tight midway down the backstretch, chased while between rivals on the turn and faded. CIEN COMMANDS was allowed to settle into stride, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. BULLET CRANE broke inward at the start, settled at the rear of the field, raced four wide on the turn and was outrun.
