DEFENDER'S WORD was bumped hard at the start, raced off the pace while urged along, rallied four wide on the turn, made a bid entering the final furlong and edged clear late under good handling. KRISTYS BOONESMILL sprinted clear and set the pace, dictated terms through the turn, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while clear for the place. HOLY ANGELO bumped twice with OLD CHUNK OF COAL after the start, moved up while ridden along, chased on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and tired. DUC D'ORLEANS was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. SOUTHERN SELECT stumbled badly at the start, chased the pace through the turn and gave way. EXPECTMONEY broke inward at the start, raced towards the rear of the field, dropped to the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. LUKEY'S LEGACY broke out and bumped hard with a rival, was ridden along while off the pace, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. CHICKASAW NATION bumped with a rival at the start, raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. PRIVATE HUMOR was urged along in the middle of the field, raced three wide on the turn and faded. OLD CHUNK OF COAL bumped twice with HOLY ANGELO after the start, dropped back while ridden along, steadied near the seven-sixteenths pole and retreated.
