STAKES Irving Distaff S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$10,500 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 114 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; \$15,000 twice in 2008, 5 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2007-2008, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to benamed through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Highweights Preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2006-2007, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, April 17, 2008 with 38 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.) (Rail at 20 feet).

Footnotes

TEARS I CRY raced three wide into the first turn then dropped to the rail, was well placed on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out to make a bid at the top of the stretch, disposed of COACH MIKE nearing the furlong marker and drew away under strong urging. MY THREE SISTERS settled while off the rail, steadied slightly near the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and got up for the place. EMMA GRACE was taken back at the start, lingered towards the rear of the field, raced four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly to just miss the place. BARBETTE dropped back at the start, was unhurried at the rear, steadied leaving the far turn, came between rivals in upper stretch and finished willingly but reached her best stride too late. RICE 'N SPICE was reserved towards the rear, waited while blocked on the far turn, steadied inside the quarter-pole and also improved position but failed to menace. JENZ BENZ settled on the inside, checked inside the quarter-pole, steadied while blocked from the three-sixteenths pole into the final furlong and lost any chance. COACH MIKE contested the pace on the inside, vied into upper stretch and gave way. HARTFELT raced four wide into the first turn then dropped in, settled towards the front of the field, was urged along on the far turn and came up empty. MISS PEACHTREE was off slow, raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. MYSTIC SOUL contested the pace, vied into the

stretch and tired. ELLIECAT raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 20 Feet)
