Footnotes

ONLY MAN IN TOWN tracked the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader near the seven-sixteenths pole, was asked for his best in upper stretch, inched clear inside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. HURRICANE DAY lagged at the rear of the field, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and finished with good energy to just get the place. JUMP IN LINE set the pace on the inside, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished then caught for the place at the wire. KISS MY KRISS raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went three wide while under urging on the far turn and finished willingly but missed the minor awards. B'WANAGOLDMINE bumped soundly with CHANDAS nearing the first turn then steadied, was reserved near the back, moved out on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. TATNALL STREET raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along on the far turn and failed to rally. CHANDAS bumped with B'WANAGOLDMINE nearing the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn and failed to respond. Following a stewards' inquiry into the bumping near the three-quarter pole, there was no change made. (Rail at 20 Feet)
