Footnotes

BLACK IDA'S JO JO chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled with the runner-up in the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. CHARLIE AND CHRIS bumped soundly with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside of two opponents, vied along the rail on the turn, drifted off the inside at the top of the stretch, battled with the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the place. WIMBLEDON STAR was fractious in the gate, stumbled at the start but broke with the field, was urged along on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. WILBY'S RAY disputed the pace between rivals, hesitated while dropping back inside the quarter-pole and tired. WEBSTER disputed the pace the outermost of three, vied three wide on the turn, moved in after dropping back near the furlong marker and weakened. STORM CAT HEIR bumped soundly with an opponent at the start, was urged along towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. GREAT HOPE was hustled early then well placed just off the pace, dropped back while inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. MALABAR SLEW lacked early speed, was ridden along at the rear, went three wide on the turn and was no factor.
