SEA BLOOM tracked the pace three wide, engaged RUTHY RED leaving the turn, dueled with that rival through the stretch, and prevailed late. RUTHY RED was away very alertly, dueled gamely throughout, and was overtaken in the final yards. U K TRICK was well placed behind the leading group, but lacked the needed response in the stretch. KEENE LADY was ridden along to be in mid pack, and raced evenly throughout. EBONY POST raced in the second flight, went four wide on the turn, and finished evenly. TYPICAL SITUATION dueled for the lead early, dropped out on the turn, and faded. WIRE LASS saved ground to no avail. TULSA SLEW was off slowly, raced four wide on the turn, angled seven wide entering the stretch, and was no factor. MISS KITTY SLEW showed no speed, and never reached contention. STREET LADY hesitated at the start, raced four wide on the turn, and failed to menace.
