**Footnotes**

TATES MANDATE hopped at the start and broke a bit slow, quickly moved up between rivals, dueled on the outside, vied four wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail, kicked clear entering the stretch and held well under strong right hand urging. MIDNIGHT WALK showed speed between rivals, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased three then four wide on the turn and finished willingly to get the place. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION dueled between horses, chased the leaders on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and also finished willingly but missed the place. I LOVE broke a bit slow, dueled for the lead, vied three wide early on the turn then dropped to the rail, lost touch with the winner entering the stretch and weakened. WINNING FLAMES dropped back at the start, raced at the rear of the field, went five to six wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. HONORABLE LIFE settled off the pace, was blocked midway through the turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. GLENNERS showed good speed, lugged out a bit while pressing the pace, had the rider lose his right rein entering the turn, raced five wide on that turn, continued without the right rein throughout and failed to respond. MY BAKARI was hustled from the start, dropped back while ridden along and was no factor. WATERSHED was ridden along towards the rear of the field, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. STALWART'S HEIR dueled on the inside, chased while saving ground on the turn and tired.
