Footnotes

DANCING DUDETE settled at the rear of the field, swung out in upper stretch and closed well to get up late. ILLUMINIQUE dueled on the inside of rivals, battled gamely in the stretch but missed. COMANCHE VISION broke outward and bumped with a rival, jostled with DIXIE DUST early on the backstretch, settled on the inside of that rival, raced three wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed well to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole but was outfinished while clear for the show. HARLEY GIRL settled near the inside, waited while blocked passing the quarter-pole, was roused at the top of the stretch, lacked room near the sixteenth then altered course to the outside and lost any chance. STILETTOS FLYIN showed good speed, pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. DIXIE DUST bumped with a rival at the start, jostled with COMANCHE VISION early on the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. O MY DARLIN DIANE was reluctant to load, rushed up between rivals to duel for the lead, dropped out entering the stretch and faded.
