SHEWANTSAPRENUP was a bit reluctant to load, came away in good order then was hustled to the lead, lugged out leaving the chute, set the clear pace while well out on the track, came under some pressure near the half-mile pole, vied three wide on the turn, shook off rivals in upper stretch and edged clear under strong urging. ALLEY AVENUE settled off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, advanced on the outside, loomed a threat into upper stretch but was second best. TRISKEL settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. DAKOTA ADIEU was urged along in third position, moved up outside the half-mile pole, vied inside of the winner on the turn and tired. SISTER SIX was recalcitrant behind the gate and reluctant to load, chased the pace on the outside then dropped back, raced three to four wide on the turn and capitulated. LITTLE ABBIE was urged along at the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor.
